PORTLAND COUNSELING PROGRAM/STUDENT OUTCOMES REPORT

The Portland Master of Arts in Counseling (MAC) program site welcomed a wonderful incoming class of future professional counselors. Dr. Jeremiah Peck (Assistant Professor) continued filling the role of Program Director. Dr. Rachel Heffield (Assistant Professor) continued to fill the role of Center Chair over Western Seminary's Master of Arts in Counseling programs at all campuses. Faculty engaged in ongoing efforts to attract, enroll, and retain a diverse student body. Using feedback from stakeholders, they also updated the Program Objectives, Key Performance Indicators, and Program Evaluation. The Western Seminary Portland MAC program holds an eight-year CACREP re-accreditation, effective until March 31, 2031.

In review of the 2022-2023 data, the following are salient points of information:

- GRADUATES: 18
- THE FOUR-YEAR COMPLETION RATE: 60
- NCE/MCMHCE EXAMINATION PASS RATE: 100% of 2023-2024 examinees (3 students/alumni took the NCE; 3 students/alumni passed)
- JOB PLACEMENT RATE OF GRADUATES: 86%
