## HISTORY OF WESTERN SEMINARY

Portland Baptist Bible Institute was organized in the winter of 1925, and The Western Baptist Theological Seminary was officially dedicated on October 4, 1927 to provide a theological education of greater depth in the Northwestern United States. Though its name has changed to Western Seminary, its focus continues to be on teaching a conservative and evangelical Christian doctrine, with a progressive philosophy of ministry in and alongside the Church.

Western Seminary has opened several extension locations in the Western United States to support residential studies in other major cities. The seminary came to Sacramento in 1991 subsequent to launching in San Jose in 1986.

Western Seminary's mission statement preserves the heart of its founding vision while contextualizing it to current needs and opportunities. The statement reads, "Western Seminary serves as a catalyst and resource for spiritual transformation by providing, with and for the church, advanced training for strategic ministry roles." Flowing from this mission is a set of values that guide its implementation: "All Western Seminary training shall be thoroughly biblical in its conviction, faithfully conservative in its theology, intensely missional in its focus, creatively flexible in its delivery, and warmly relational in its dynamic." It is because of your support for these pastors, counselors, missionaries, chaplains, teachers, and more, that we are able to celebrate their accomplishments and futures today.

# WESTERN SEMINARY

## PURPOSE STATEMENT

The tradition of academic dress began centuries ago in chilly universities where cap, gown and hood were needed for covering and warmth. Subsequently, this has become a ceremonial costume with certain standardized features.

Sleeves in the bachelor's gown are pointed; in the master's gown, oblong with arms projecting at the elbow; in the doctor's gown, bell-shaped. The doctor's gown is faced with velvet with three matching stripes on the sleeves, and the hood is lined with the official colors of the degree-conferring institution.

Western Seminary's school colors are blue and gold. Graduates in Biblical and Theological Studies, Ministry and Leadership, and Divinity will receive a hood with red trim, while graduates in Counseling and Marital and Family Therapy will receive a hood with white trim.

## IN MEMORIAM

*Dr. Bloomquist died tragically in a car accident on May 1, 2021, along with her sister, Lisa Holland, eight-month-old nephew, Milo Holland, and her two dogs. Laurie taught at Western Seminary beginning in 2010 as an adjunct professor, and from 2016 to 2020 as a full-time Assistant Professor of Counseling. As a much-loved professor, she had a powerful impact on students and colleagues alike.
